Minda now seeks volunteers to travel to locations across Adelaide and SA to install, collect, replace and empty our coin collection units.

Businesses across SA have generously provided countertop space to host a Minda Coin Collection 'house', encouraging customers to donate to make a difference to people living with disabilities. We seek volunteers who enjoy driving, building relationships and making a difference. Volunteers will work in pairs, travelling to locations across Adelaide or further afield in regional SA to install coin collection units, then periodically empty and replace units during business hours. An ongoing commitment of at least one day every three months.

Additional information:

- Transport, petrol, meals and accommodation may be provided when required (eg for regional overnight stays).
- A current DCSI is required or volunteers must be willing to undergo check (free of charge).
- If driving a current SA Drivers Licence (C) is essential and volunteers must be confident navigating and driving in the city and/or country areas.
- Some basic manual labour may be required.
